9) Misrepresentation and fraud:

Where a team is not the National Team acting under the authority of the National Federation and/or respective National Olympic Committee - and/or where a competition has not been duly sanctioned by the WBSC – the uniform colours and style of such team competing in an international competition must not be the same as or similar to any National Team uniforms of the WBSC Member. The National Flag of the country of that National Federation must not appear on the uniform and such team should not be promoted/positioned as a team representing a country or nation on any media outlets (broadcasting, website, social media, print publications, etc.).

- ♦ Base runners may attempt to advance at any time while the ball is alive and in play.
- ♦ The home run distance is subject to the actual field conditions and will be announced at the Pre-tournament Meeting.

The bat shall be made of wood or of other materials as it complies with the specifications

- It shall be a smooth, rounded stick with a constant radius at any point.
- There must be a direct line from the center of the knob to the center of the large end.
- The knob and the end plug, if any, must be firmly attached.
- One-piece wood bats can be used as long as they are included in the current year’s Official List of Approved Bats by the World Baseball Softball Confederation (WBSC).
- Non-wood or multi-piece wood bats shall have a Bat Performance Factor (BPF) of 1.15 or less. If the BPF is not visibly indicated on the bat, manufacturer’s proof and/or alternate equivalent certification may be presented to the Technical Commission for approval.

e) Protective Equipment

Double ear-flap helmet is mandatory for the hitter and base-runners, and it is also recommended that base coaches wear the skull caps.

Note: the skull caps for coaches are not required, only recommended.

- ♦ Pitch counts from all games pitched by the same pitcher on the same day shall be aggregated, and the cumulative total will apply for the purpose of determining eligibility to pitch in subsequent games.

- ◆ Two (2) completed innings shall constitute a regulation game.
